Bernstein Trio

The Bernstein Trio was founded in 2022 and consists of Roman Tulchynsky (violin), Marei Schibilsky (cello), and Julia Stephan (piano). The musicians met at the *Carl Philipp Emanuel Bach Gymnasium* in Berlin and are currently studying at the *Universität der Künste Berlin* and the *Hochschule für Musik Hanns Eisler Berlin*. As an ensemble, they receive coaching from Jonathan Auer.

The Bernstein Trio has participated in various masterclasses in Germany, France, and Switzerland, working with artists such as Antoine Tamestit, Valentin Erben, Dirk Mommertz, Nicolas Altstaedt, Isang Enders, the Artemis Quartet, the Vogler Quartet, the Ariel Quartet, the Boulanger Trio, and others. They made their debut in the summer of 2023 at the *Rheingau Musik Festival*, where they received the *Förderpreis der HA Hessen Agentur GmbH*. At the *Deutscher Musikwettbewerb 2024*, the trio was awarded a scholarship and was included in the Concert Promotion of the *DMW*, also receiving a special prize from the *Freunde junger Musiker Meerbusch Düsseldorf e.V.* At the *Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy Hochschulwettbewerb 2025*, they won 1st prize, the special prize for the commissioned composition, and the special prize from the *Freunde junger Musiker*. Additionally, the Bernstein Trio received the 3rd prize at the international chamber music competition „*Schubert und die Musik der Moderne*“ in 2025. In the same month, the ensemble won the 1st prize and the special prize of the *Schumann-Gesellschaft* at the international *Schumann-Kammermusikpreis* in Frankfurt.

Since 2022, the Bernstein Trio has been supported by the „*Yehudi Menuhin Live Music Now Berlin*“ association. All members of the ensemble are scholars of the *Studienstiftung des Deutschen Volkes*.
